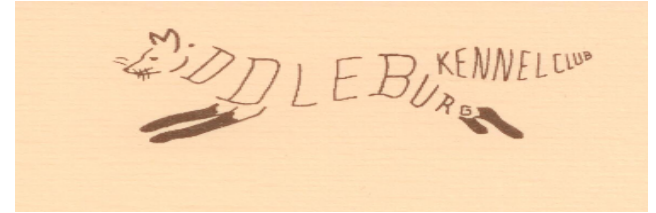

AKC Agility Course Test (ACT 1 and 2)

Saturday, April 21, 2018

ACT Evaluator: Kim Matson

Come earn an agility title on your beginner dog in a trial atmosphere! The Agility Course Test is an entry level agility event to introduce beginning dogs and/or handlers to the sport of agility. Dogs must be 15 months or older to enter and must meet the requirements for a regular AKC agility trial (Chapter 1, Section 3), except that they do not need to be registered with AKC to enter.

ACT Level 1 is open to dogs that have not earned any AKC agility titles. The course will have 10-12 obstacles: 5' A-frame, table, tunnels, and bar jumps (no spread jumps); tire & panel jumps are allowed but not required. Time for all jump heights is 60 seconds with a minimum score of 85 to Qualify. Two Qualifying runs earn the title – ACT1.

ACT Level 2 is open to dogs that have not earned a title in any AKC Agility class except an ACT1 title. Level 2 courses have 11-13 obstacles: all of the obstacles in Level 1 plus a teeter, 6 weaves, tire, and 1 spread jump (triple, double, or broad); the dog walk is allowed but not required. Time for all jump heights is 70 seconds with a minimum score of 85 to Qualify. Two Qualifying runs earn the title – ACT 2.

Refusals & Run-outs are not judged. More than 3 attempts at an obstacle will result in an elimination (failure). The rest of the faults are the same as in the regular agility classes. All passing scores can be under the same judge. Only one dog in the ring at a time.

Dogs may be entered at any of the following jump height divisions: 4, 8, 12, 16, 20 or 24 inches, handler's choice. A jump height card is not required. Dogs will not be measured.

Fees: Pre-Entry Only, \$15.00 per Run (includes \$5 AKC recording fee); **Junior Handlers - Fee: \$10/run**

Day of Event, \$20.00 per Run

Middleburg Kennel Club Members, \$12.00 per Run

Total Entry is limited to 60 total runs per day.

Agility Course Tests

The Agility Course Test (ACT) is an entry level agility event to introduce beginning dogs and handlers to the sport of agility and the AKC agility program.

ACT EVENT

There are two levels of ACT events – ACT1 and ACT2. ACT 1 is designed for the beginning level dog to show beginning sequencing and performance skills. ACT2 requires an increased skill level shown by the additional obstacles to be performed.

ACT Level 1 is open to dogs that have not earned any AKC agility titles. The course will have 10-12 obstacles: 5' A-frame, table, tunnels, and bar jumps (no spread jumps); tire & panel jumps are allowed but not required. Time for all jump heights is 60 seconds with a minimum score of 85 to Qualify. Two Qualifying runs earn the title – ACT1.

ACT Level 2 is open to dogs that have not earned a title in any AKC Agility class except an ACT1 title. Level 2 courses have 11-13 obstacles: all of the obstacles in Level 1 plus a teeter, 6 weaves, tire, and 1 spread jump (triple, double, or broad); the dog walk is allowed but not required. Time for all jump heights is 70 seconds with a minimum score of 85 to Qualify. Two Qualifying runs earn the title – ACT2.

Refusals & Run-outs are not judged. More than 3 attempts at an obstacle will result in an elimination (failure). The rest of the faults are the same as in the regular agility classes. All passing scores can be under the same judge. Only one dog in the ring at a time. Dogs may be entered at any of the following jump height divisions: 4, 8, 12, 16, 20 or 24 inches, handler's choice. A jump height card is not required. Dogs will not be measured.

For the clubs, their members, directors, and the employees of the said kennel/agility clubs will not be liable for any loss or injury which may be sustained through the disappearance, loss, theft, injury, and/or death of dogs entered in the said events, whether said disappearance, loss, theft, injury and/or death is caused by the negligence or carelessness of said kennel/agility clubs, their directors, and/or employees. **The kennel/agility clubs** are not responsible for the actions or products of commercial vendors at these events.

The welfare of a handler's or spectator's child is the responsibility of the handler or spectator. It is expressly understood that handler or spectator will exercise control and restraint over their children on the days of the events.

SITE RULES:

PRONG, PINCH, HEAD HALTERS, SPECIAL TRAINING, AND SHOCK COLLARS OF ALL STYLES ARE PROHIBITED. *Owner/handler and dog(s) will be asked to leave the property. No refund of entry fee(s) will be given when this violation is the cause for removal.*

STROLLERS WITH CHILDREN ON BOARD NOT ALLOWED IN THE AGILITY BUILDING.

NO RETRACTING LEADS ALLOWED IN SHOW BUILDING OR NEAR THE RING.

NO DOGS ALLOWED IN THE BATHROOMS.

OWNERS/HANDLERS ARE REQUIRED TO PICK UP AFTER THEIR DOGS.

THE DESIGNATED WARM-UP AREA. NO PRACTICING IN THE RINGS IS ALLOWED AT ANYTIME.

LEASHES:

ALL DOGS MUST BE ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES, EXCEPT WHEN CRATED, IN THE RING, OR IN At the handler's option, dogs may run a course with or without a collar. The only collars allowed when running a course are flat buckle or rolled leather collars, but there shall be no attachments hanging or otherwise allowed on the collar. This shall not preclude painted or stitched designs or information on the collar. Dog's names and/or identifying information may appear on the collar. No title, awards, or advertising may appear on the collar. Dogs may be brought to the start line on slip leads, choke chains, body harnesses or other collars that are permitted on the trial grounds.

A leash may not have excess material dangling from it, nor may it have any attachments including a fleece or leather wrap. The leash may have a single pick-up bag and/or identification tag attached to it.

ELIGIBILITY OF DOGS. *All dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older may enter a test. Dogs must be physically sound as described in Chapter 1, Section 3, Paragraph 7 of the Regulations for Agility Trials. In order to acquire the title certificate and have the title added to a dog's record, the dog must be registered/listed with the AKC Canine Partner applications may be accepted at the test by the judge/evaluator and submitted with test results.*

HEALTH: *Owners/handlers should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to ensure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.*

BITCHES IN SEASON *shall not be permitted to compete.*

MIXED BREEDS. *All mixed breed dogs are welcome to participate in the AKC ACT Program. Under "Breed" on the entry form, dogs must be listed as "All American" and not as a breed hybrid. If you would like to register your dog with AKC, we will be able to assist you with on-line registration at the event.*

Dogs that are not AKC registered/listed may participate and their performance will be recorded by the AKC under a temporary recording number. This temporary recording number will be e-mailed to the owner and must be used when entering subsequent ACT events and when the owner registers/lists the dog. Note: Temporary recording numbers may only be used to enter ACT events.

JUMP HEIGHT DIVISIONS. *Dogs may be entered at any of the following jump height divisions: 4, 8, 12, 16, 20 or 24 inches.*

OBSTACLES: *All the obstacles will conform to the requirements in the current edition of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.*

DIRECTIONS: Periland Agility, 511 Jefferson Pike, Knoxville, MD 21758

FROM FREDERICK, MD:

From any of the three major highways leading to Frederick, MD, I-270, I-70, Route 15, exit onto Route 340 west

- **Go 11 miles on Route 340 west, then exit onto Route 17. At the top of the exit ramp, enter the circle and take 3rd exit onto Route 17 south towards Sheetz and McDonalds.**
- **Go ¼ mile and enter circle, take 1st exit off circle onto Route 180 west.**
- **Follow Route 180 west (Jefferson Pike) 1 mile to trial site on your left.**
- **After entering the property, turn right and follow the drive way to the new building**

FROM CHARLES TOWN, WV:

- **From Charlestown WV, take Route 340 east into Maryland**
- **Exit Route 340 on MD 180 towards Knoxville/Brunswick**
- **Follow MD 180 (Jefferson Pike) 1 mile to trial site on your right.**
- **After entering the property, turn right and follow the drive way to the new building**

NO ON-LINE ENTRIES.

HAND DELIVERY OF ENTRIES, delivered to Periland Agility Center, will be accepted only during the open Pre-Entry registration dates. None will be accepted after the Pre-Entry closing date. Day-of-Event entries will be accepted that day at the Periland Agility site.

ALL ENTRIES SHALL BE MADE ON THE OFFICIAL AKC FORM

Pre-Entry Closing Date: April 11, 2018 at 6:00 pm includes the official Agreement and Rules found on the 2nd page of said form.

ALL ENTRIES MUST INCLUDE THE ENTRY FEE(S) AND SIGNED, to be accepted.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE OR ACCEPTED which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

ERRORS ON ENTRY FORMS: Owners are responsible for the accuracy of the forms.

REFUNDS:

No Entry Fee Refund will be made if the form(s) contain errors.

No Entry Fee Refund will be made in the event the dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by the Trial Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbances, extreme weather, or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or complete the trial, no entry fee(s) will be refunded.

No Entry Fee Refund will be made for injury or illness after entries close.

CANCELLATIONS: In order for cancellations sent via mail to be valid, exhibitors must receive an acknowledgement from the trial secretary. If you do not receive an acknowledgment, assume that your request has not been received. No refunds or changes will be made without the trial secretary's acknowledgment.

All refund requests received prior to the close of Pre-Entries will be charged a \$5.00 processing fee.

Bitches in season: After the close of Pre-Entries, only refund requests for bitches in season can be accepted. Such requests must include a veterinarian's note and be received by the trial secretary no later than ½ hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial. After the close of Pre-Entries, a processing fee of \$5.00 will be withheld from refunds for bitches entered in each her classes.

I (we) agree that the club or ACT Evaluator, holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club or ACT Evaluator shall deem sufficient. I (we) certify and represent that the dog entered is not a hazard to persons or other dogs. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents, event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge or ACT Evaluator, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog. Dogs may be entered in any jump height. There is no Regular or Preferred distinction at AKC's ACT events.

In order to acquire the ACT1 or ACT2 title certificate and have the title added to a dog's record, the dog must be registered/listed with the American Kennel Club. **AKC Canine PartnersSM** applications may be accepted at the event and submitted to AKC with the event's results.

Dogs that are not AKC registered/listed may be registered at a later date and receive their ACT title at that time.

Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnersSM** program should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler Number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
